- I. Margarita Mogollon began the meeting with a summary of the last Educator's Workgroup and a hands-on 'walk-through' of the new features of the Project Clean Water website.
- II. The K-12 Survey to the Copermittees was reviewed. Three Copermittees were on hand to complete the survey at the last Technical Outreach Workgroup and completed the survey. The survey taken again to the next Technical Outreach Workgroup and emailed afterwards to any remaining copermittees with an 'attention getter'.
- III. Michele Stress gave the update for the Technical Outreach Workgroup. Dates and locations for the workshop series for mobile businesses are set for February. Copermittees gave the final vote for 3 Regional movie slide ads to be aired this spring. Copermittees discussed applying remaining outreach funds to one of four possible strategies this year. Strategies for next year include an Integrated Pest Management education and outreach program and the creation of a Speakers bureau rather than sponsoring new workshops.
- IV. Pam Villa, County of San Diego, DEH GIS Coordinator gave a presentation on the value and potential of GIS mapping of regional water-related environmental education activities. Margarita distributed the menu of the information needed from each agency for GIS mapping. A suggestion was made to make this an online form which has the capability to automatically dump into Excel or Access.
- V. Margarita Mogollon distributed and discussed a draft overview of a report on using the Used Oil Program Evaluation Guide as a model for water-related education & outreach activities. The chapter on school outreach evaluation (Chapter 7) was distributed for review. Members are asked to give comments and specific suggestions related to water education.
