

Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) Member:

Please find attached the Data Gathering Technical Memorandum for the San Diego Region Stormwater Capture and Use Feasibility Study (SWCFS). This Technical Memorandum documents the first steps in the SWCFS assessment that includes the development of the analysis framework and data collection. During the first TAC meeting on July 18, 2017, a data needs list was provided. Based on feedback from the TAC at this meeting, further clarifications were provided to the data needs list, and distributed to the TAC on July 24, 2017, with a request for data by August 8, 2017. The attached memo includes a summary of the data compiled from the Project Team and from the TAC to date.
